History of Banat-Triplex Confinium EGTC

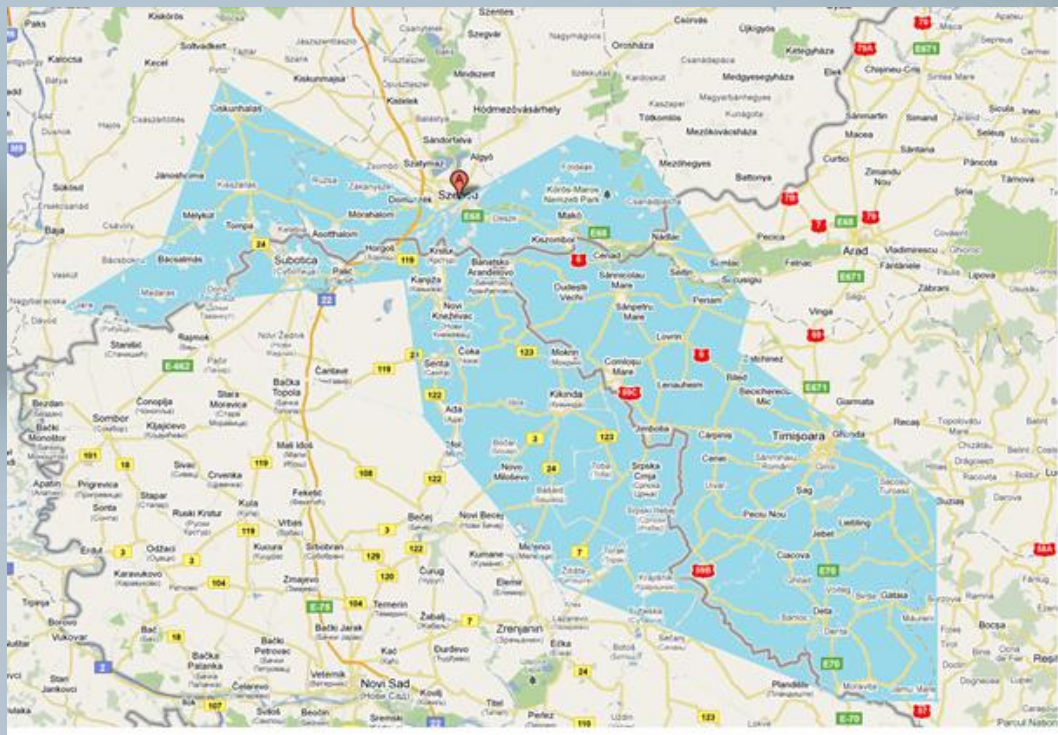
- Formation of Banat-Triplex Confinium (Hungary-Romania full membership-Serbia as observer member)
